



Training: Introduction to the active pedagogy, Help me do it alone!

Context:

The active pedagogy, or the experimental education, puts the child at the center of its learning, thanks to a rich and adapted learning environment.

It privileges authentic situations of research and investigation during which the child must understand and master the various resources that the guide puts at his disposal.

This choice of pedagogy is justified by the fact that it does not require the facilitator to have a high level of education, and can therefore be a person from the village, provided that she can read, write and count, and of course be kind and loving to the children.

The active pedagogy introduced in pre-school years develops within the children soft skills that will give the children an absolute head start in their life long learning journey.

Objectives:

- The child is actor of his learning, developing a sense of responsibility
- Develop practical/ **soft skills that will help him in everyday life, and that will greatly facilitate future learning in the context they live in:** curiosity, initiative and perseverance, concentration
- Develop **self-confidence, self-reliance and self-discipline**
- Stimulate judgment and sensory discrimination
- Help children develop socially.

The training:

During this training, Latifa Esshikh will be introduced to the educational material of each of the 5 "corners" that characterize the Montessori class:

The practical life corner: develops adaptation in time and space, autonomy, coordination, order, self-confidence

The sensory corner: to clarify the abilities and sensory perceptions of the child, a precious support for the good development of his intelligence.

The mathematical corner, the language corner and the discovery corner of the world (geography, history, botany ...)

Natalia Angel will spend 1 week, twice during the school year, in October and in February to set up the class, support Latifa and build the teaching material locally, inspired by the Reggio Emilia pedagogy and other.

Target:

Latifa Esshikh is the educator for the children 3 to 6 years old in the DLK center in Farraha. She teaches to about 15 children every year.

Place of training:

Kid's House Montessori in Ouezzane and at the DLK center in Farraha

Schedule :

Latifa's training at the Kid's house started in March 2019, a week per month until June, then 1 day per week, during the entire 2019-2020 school year to consolidate her knowledge.

Budget : 4 150 eur
